The 1st Annual Glanville Research Retreat: 28th and 29th June 2017

Following the launch of the Eleanor Glanville Centre (21 March 2017), we will be holding our first research retreat – a 2-day residential research-development workshop. The overarching purpose of the retreat is to begin to develop interdisciplinary and cross-college research funding proposals. In order to facilitate this, a number of short workshops will be held on campus, in advance of the event, to formulate ideas and identify appropriate funding sources.

Participation will be required for the **full 2 days** (dinner and overnight accommodation is provided – but not compulsory). Places are limited to 30 participants.
